

Slated for completion in July 2017, the next phase of the Atlanta BeltLine – a new sustainable redevelopment project in Atlanta, GA – features Banker Wire mesh railing infill.

By 2030, the Atlanta BeltLine will comprise 22 miles of streetcar, 33 total miles of trails, and 2,000 acres of parks, all connecting the city's downtown neighborhoods with outlying areas and creating a network for the entire metro area.

Today, Banker Wire's SJD-3 woven wire mesh in stainless steel graces some of the BeltLine's railings amidst trails and walkways. SJD-3 is a large-scale, square window pane weave that uses a combination of two wire diameters to create a secondary pattern. The pattern offers a very high percent open area without sacrificing the integrity of the mesh.

As a result, the railings offer a beautiful and sustainable complement to the expanded regional transit and transportation network, which is one of the largest urban redevelopment programs currently underway in the United States.
