


THE HIGH ROLLER

The world's tallest observation wheel, the LINQ's High Roller, opened in Las Vegas on March 31. Railings featuring Banker Wire woven wire mesh guide visitors onto the 550-foot High Roller, which takes them on 30-minute rides high above the Las Vegas strip.

"Southwest Architectural Metals teamed directly with the architect to redesign a custom stainless steel railing system that uses Banker Wire's Versatile Spine frame and R.B. Wagner's illuminated handrail," says senior project manager Matt Wright, of Southwest Architectural Metals, Henderson, NV, the fabricator for the project. "The outcome of the collaboration provided the owner with a superior product that was custombuilt to suit this unique project."

The Banker Wire L-62 metal fabric used at the High Roller has a contemporary look that matches the wheel's sleek aesthetic while providing strength and durability. The Versatile Spine frame was also used to work seamlessly with the illuminated handrail - it's a stylish alternative to traditional framing and provides a strong interface for the woven wire mesh.
