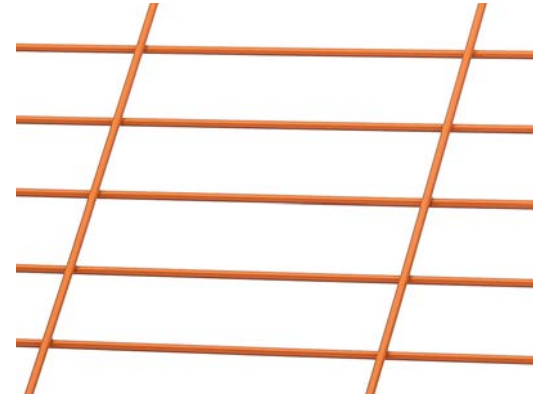


HORSEPEN RESIDENCE

Ornamental Welded Wire Mesh Railing Panels
Tybee Island, Georgia, USA

WDZ-615



To create a drop-down staircase railing in his private residence, Omega Steel Inc co-owner and fabricator Ryan Taylor looked to Banker Wire mesh WDZ-615—a 2" by 8" rectangular ornamental welded wire mesh pattern that celebrates simplicity.

"When we have used a wire mesh material at Omega Steel, it has mostly been an industrial mesh, within industrial settings," explains Taylor. "After discovering Banker Wire's architectural wire mesh product—and the range of finishes available—we knew it would be the perfect fit. We selected the WDZ-615 pattern, framed within U-edge panels and tabs. Powder coated in Raven Black, the material provided a cleaner, architectural finish for our home, compared to the other wire mesh on the market, which isn't always a fit for residential settings."

The secondary finish of the Raven Black-colored powder coat—alongside the walnut-capped railing posts—complements the dark accents within the space, providing visual continuity. Walnut kitchen cabinets with black hardware, and a black faucet, provide detail within the kitchen; in the living room, walnut-colored finishes provide a warm contrast to the black and walnut mantel, and the metal doors connecting to the exterior.
