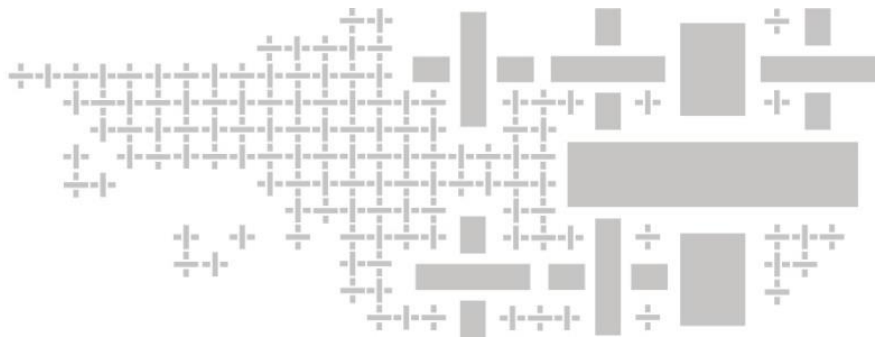
Work Experience: Must have proven mechanical experience, or hands-on experience working with metal.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Set-up, program and run automatic/manual looms
- Trouble shoot, diagnose, and perform change-overs
- Ensure the quality of our woven mesh is up to company standards
- Conduct quality assessments on finished products
- Perform necessary pre-operation activities to ensure proper equipment startup and operation on multiple pieces of equipment
- Adjusting length and square accurately and efficiently
- Warping the loom to specifications accurately
- Setting up the loom and shear accurately and efficiently
- Adjusting the loom settings to optimize production and quality
- Accurately measuring and recording pitch and all required loom settings
- Reading simple blue prints
- Constantly striving for high production numbers while producing a high quality/zero defect material
- Adjusting and setting-up the wire straightener accurately and efficiently
- Setting-up various straighteners and turntables accurately
- Able to change or set crimp depth and phase
- Able to adjust and set roll plate
- Install and remove tooling (wheels)
- Review job sheets and log in/out at the start and finish of each job
- Roll, band and tag rolls, move sheets to skids, move skids and empty stems to appropriate locations and ensure proper tags are affixed, keep crimpers supplied with wire and move long wires and cross wires when needed
- Follow all safety procedures and ensure cleanliness and proper maintenance of the work areas
- Clean Loom Line (Shear, Crimpers etc.) at the end of the shift
